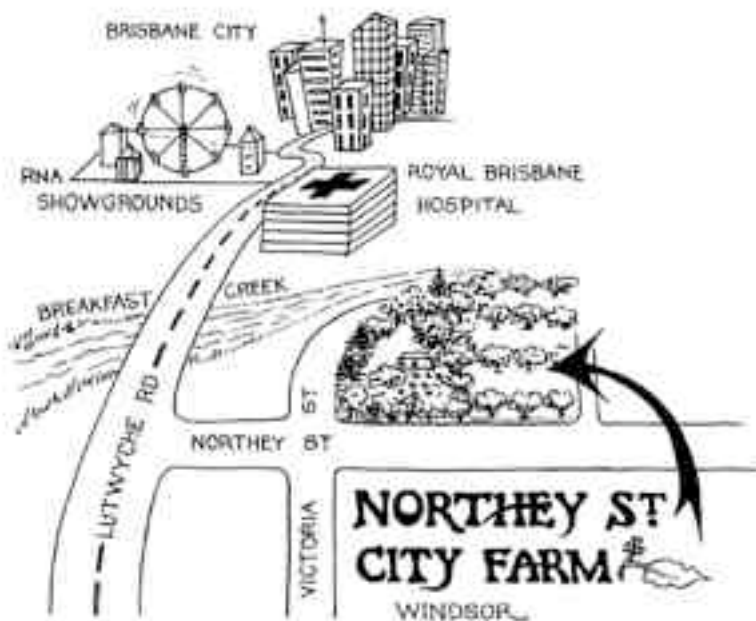
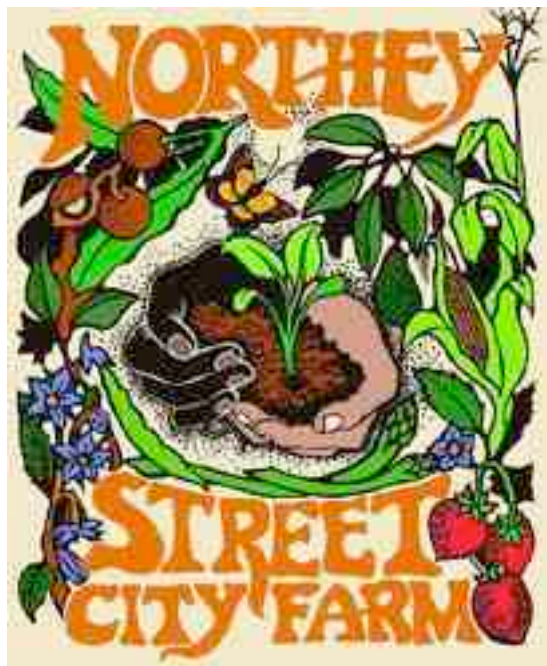


We're doing this event in conjunction with [Food Connect](#), a
